Applications for UNESCO funding to attend ICWES19 virtually CALL is now OPEN

The call for applications for receiving funding to register for the virtual participation to the 19th International Conference of Women Engineers and Scientists (ICWES19) on 4-6 September 2023 is now open. The funding is provided by the UNESCO Participation Programme 2022-23.

Applicants must be:

a. Residents of the Least Developed Countries (LDC) as per the official <u>DAC List of ODA Recipients</u>, left column (LDC) as a First Priority.

OR

Residents of the Lower Middle Income Countries Upper Middle Income Countries and Territories as per the official DAC List of ODA Recipients, third column as a Second Priority

AND

b. Members of an INWES organizational member or an individual INWES member in good standing.

Priority will be given to applicants with accepted paper, workshop, poster or panel to be included in the ICWES19 programme. Presenters can deliver their presentation live or provide a pre-recorded video.

Applicants are encouraged to invite a group of participants to join in live for common viewings, thus allowing for networking and local interactions. The call will provide approximately **35 registrations** to attend the hybrid conference ICWES19 virtually.

The funding will cover **only the registration fees to the ICWES19 virtual** sessions. The hybrid conference will be streamed via Zoom.

To apply, submit before the deadline:

- a. A maximum of 150 words on 'Why you want to attend ICWES19 and why you should receive the funding'
- a. Proof of paper acceptance from the organizers (if any).
